SYMPOSIUM 2024 RULES:

TEAM CRITERIA –

- 1) Teams should consist of a minimum of 8 and maximum of 12 members, including the speakers, the researchers, and the techies. All members must be undergraduates (including interns).
- 2) The team should have a minimum of 4 and maximum of 6 speakers in total.
- 3) A team can comprise of members from different medical colleges (inter college participation is accepted)
- 4) Each team should select a **MEDICALLY** relevant research topic and complete literature review, study design, data collection and analysis.

ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

- 1) A short abstract to be submitted in the specified format along with the required documents as outlined by the Symposium team
- 2) Approval from the respective college's ethical committee must be obtained.
- 3) Teams selected from the short abstracts must submit a detailed long abstract by the specified deadline.
- 4) plagiarism will not be tolerated. Any contents sourced from articles must be properly cited with appropriate references.

SYMPOSIUM PRELIMINARY ROUND

- 1) Selected teams will participate in the preliminary round of the symposium on October 1st and 2nd.
- 2) During the preliminary round, each team is required to deliver an audio-visual presentation of their research.
- 3) Speakers are strictly prohibited from bringing any reference materials onto the stage during their presentations.
- 4) Participants are advised to dress formally for the event, with preferred attire including blazers or suits. Additionally, all participants must carry their Oscar 2024 ID.

TIME ALLOCATION

Total Time Allotted: All participants have 14 minutes in total.

Technical Setup: An additional 2 minutes will be provided for technical setup.

Presentation Time: The audio-visual presentation should not exceed 10 minutes. Exceeding this time will result in a score deduction.

Time Alerts:

- The first bell will ring at 8 minutes.
- The second bell will ring at 10 minutes.

Q&A Round:

- 3 minutes for questions from the judges.
- 2 minutes for questions from the audience and or organiser

Adherence: Ensure strict adherence to the time limits to avoid score deduction and disruptions.

TECHNICAL AND FORMAT PROTOCOLS:

File Formats: The visual presentation can be projected using a PowerPoint file (.ppt or .pptx) or as a video file (.MP4/.WMV/.AVI) only. Ensure the presentation is compatible with the software and plays correctly.

PowerPoint Version: The PowerPoint file must be created using MS PowerPoint 2010 or a higher version. If created with another version, ensure the final file is compatible with PowerPoint 2013/2016.

Background Music: Incorporate background music directly into the presentation file. Light music is preferable and should not overpower the speakers' voices. (Only background music is allowed; no voice-over.)

Equipment: Teams must bring their own laptops with a projector port. Only VGA/HDMI cables will be provided. (Avoid using MacBooks or other Apple products.)

Synchronization: Ensure that the speakers are in sync with the presentation file in advance.

Institution Identification: The name of the college or institute to which the team belongs must not be mentioned in the presentation or the script. A maximum of 4 microphones will be provided for speakers during the presentation.

Rehearsal Slots: Rehearsal slots will be allocated to teams prior to the event.

Consent for Videos: If the presentation includes videos of patients, a consent form must be presented.

SCORING

Teams will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

1 Research (35%)

- Methodology: Hypothesis formulation, selection criteria, data collection, and analysis.
- Results: Interpretation and discussion of findings.

2 Originality of Topic and Content (5%)

3 Audio-Visual Presentation (15%)

- Relevance of background information, content quality, and visual effects.

4 Overall Coherence and Speech Delivery (10%)

5 Relevance in Current Scenario and Message to Society (10%)

6 Response to Questions from the Judges' Panel (25%)

- THE SELECTED SHORT ABSTRACTS WILL BE REVEALED ON THE 5TH SEPTEMBER -
- ETHICAL COMMITTEE APPROVAL - WITHIN ONE WEEK OF SHORT ABSTRACT SUBMISSION
- SELECTED TEAMS SHALL PARTICIPATE IN THE PRELIMINARY ROUND WHICH WILL BE HELD OFFLINE AT OSMANIA MEDICAL COLLEGE ON THE 1ST AND SECOND OF OCTOBER
- TEAMS QUALIFIED IN THE PRELIMS ROUND SHALL PRESENT THE SAME AV AGAIN IN THE FINAL ROUND WHICH WILL BE HELD ON THE 3RD OF OCTOBER AT OSMANIA MEDICAL COLLEGE.
- SUBMISSION OF LONG ABSTRACT (REPORT) - BY 26 TH SEPTEMBER
- FINALISED AV VIDEO SHOULD BE SUBMITTED TO US BY 29 TH SEPTEMBER. (Any delay in AV submission will result in corresponding loss of points)
- REHARSALS WITH SPEAKERS AND COMPLETED AV- 27 TH AND 28 TH OF SEPTEMBER
